TCC Transfer Credits

The University of Tulsa Collins College of Business welcomes transfer students from Tulsa Community College.

General Information

Every undergraduate student at The University of Tulsa must satisfy the requirements of the Tulsa Curriculum, which include:

- General Curriculum — courses distributed over three categories, known as “blocks”
- Core Curriculum — University-wide writing, math, and foreign language requirements
- Major area of concentration
- Electives — chosen from college and University offerings

Specific Guidelines for TCC Transfer Students

- Up to one-half of your TU degree credits can be transferred from community colleges.
- Credit will be transferred from TCC courses that have an equivalent offered at TU.
- A grade of “C” or better must be earned for a course to transfer.
- Individual colleges at TU determine how transfer credits will apply toward their specific degrees.
- Courses offered at the junior and senior levels at TU cannot be transferred from community colleges.
- A minimum 2.5 GPA is required for transfer students to be admitted to TU.

NOTE: Credit will not be awarded for classes that are not listed in this brochure.

The General Curriculum

The goal of the General Curriculum is to lead students to a breadth of knowledge and intellectual rigor rooted in the academic disciplines. Collins College of Business students must complete classes in three sets of “block” classes.

Block I – Aesthetic Inquiry and Creative Experience

These courses consider the human activities of making, thinking, and doing.

Block II – Historical and Social Interpretation

Block III – Scientific Investigation

These courses focus on methods of investigation and explore the relationships among key concepts in the sciences.
